



All-Star Selection Procedures

Revised 2023

All-Star teams will consist of between 12-15 players. The range will be determined by the head coach of the All-Star team. Players must be age eligible to participate on an All-Star team.

6U, 8U, and 10U Divisions Process

- Each head coach will receive a ballot (Google Form) to select, based on his/her opinion, the top 20 players from their age division.
- The form will require the submission of 15 names, but will allow up to 20.
- The Coosa Board will receive the ballots and calculate the player rankings. The Board will review the list for any abnormalities and reserves the right to make corrections.
- The division champion head coach will be given the first opportunity to become the all-star head coach. Then the next opportunity will be given to the runner-up and so on until all coaching spots are filled.

12U Division Process

- Each head coach will select the 4 best players from their team and submit the players' names via the All-Star ballot. The ballots will come via a Google form. ***Coaches should not nominate players from other teams.**
- The 2023 12U All-Star head coach will be Kevin Vinson, head baseball coach at Sardis High School. Assistant coaches will come from the pool of league coaches
- All 20 players will participate in a skills evaluation. This evaluation will be used to select the All-Star team. Players will be evaluated by the All-Star head coach and by members of the Coosa Board. Evaluators will be individuals not currently participating in the 12U division. The team will consist of between 12-15 players.
